Ice bulletin for the St Lawrence River from Montreal to Les Escoumins and the Saguenay Fjord  
issued at 1400utc March 27, 2006 by Quebec Ice Centre of the Canadian Coast Guard.

General ice conditions

From Montreal to Cap aux Oies thin first year, greywhite and nilas, then open water to Les Escoumins.

In the Saguenay Fjord from Tadoussac to Ville La Baie and Grande Anse there is thin first year and nilas.

Trace to 1/10 thin first year

Sorel to Pte du Lac  
Open water

Pte du Lac to Bécancour  
5/10 to 8/10 thin first year

Bécancour to Deschambeault  
Open water

Deschambeault to Levis  
1/10 to 3/10 thin first year  
in strips of 9/10

Levis to Beaumont  
4/10 thin first year  
in strips of 8/10

Beaumont to Cap aux Oies  
trace to 2/10 thin first year  
trace to 2/10 nilas  
In strips of 9/10

Cap aux Oies to Les Escoumins  
Open water

Saguenay Fjord  
Tadoussac to Ville La Baie  
Trace to 1/10 thin first year  
1/10 to 3/10 nilas and new ice

Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution in the vicinity of and in ice infested waters as ice conditions may be more extensive and/or severe than reported.
